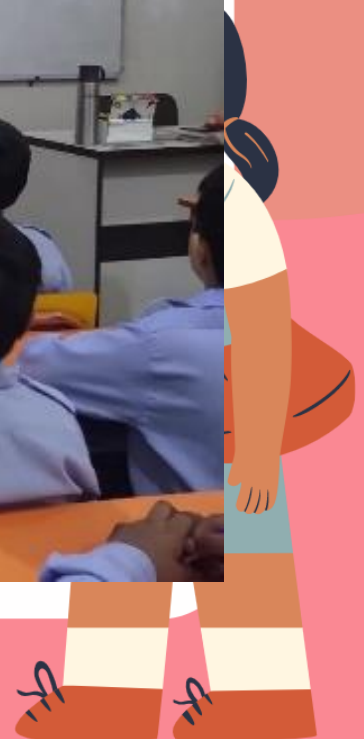

Students of class IV and V celebrate the day by watching the videos in order to gain knowledge about why this day is celebrated and create awareness among themselves. Followed by a quiz.

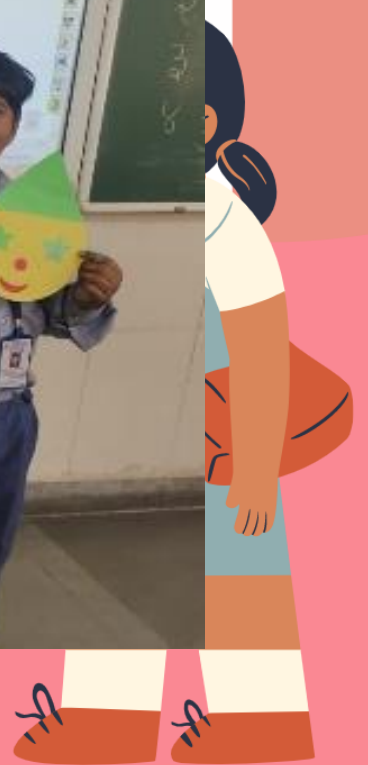

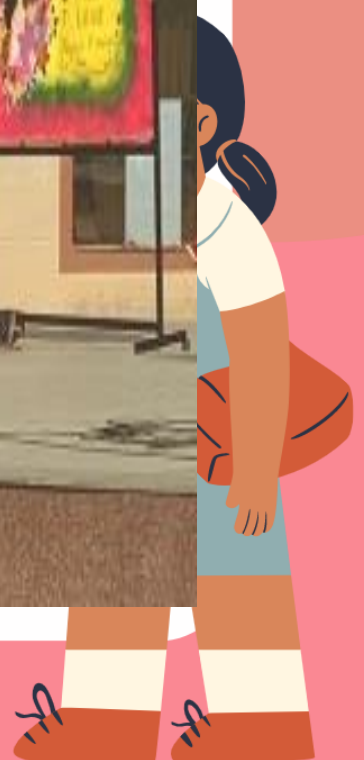


SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

LEARNING OBJECTIVE:

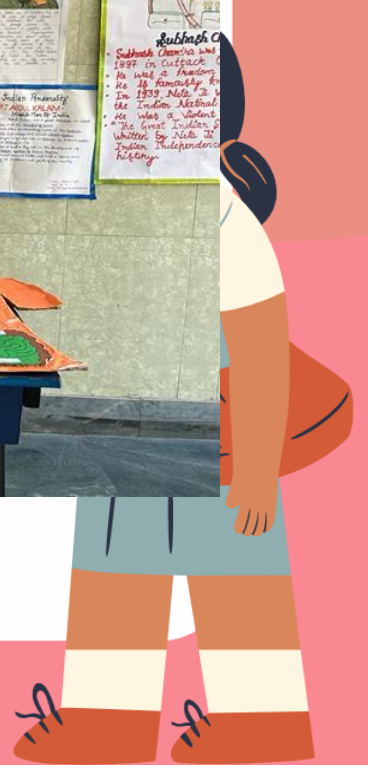
- To discuss the performance of students with their parents..

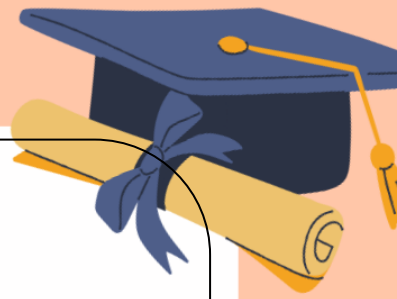
योगासन व प्राथमिक चिकित्सा बक्सा

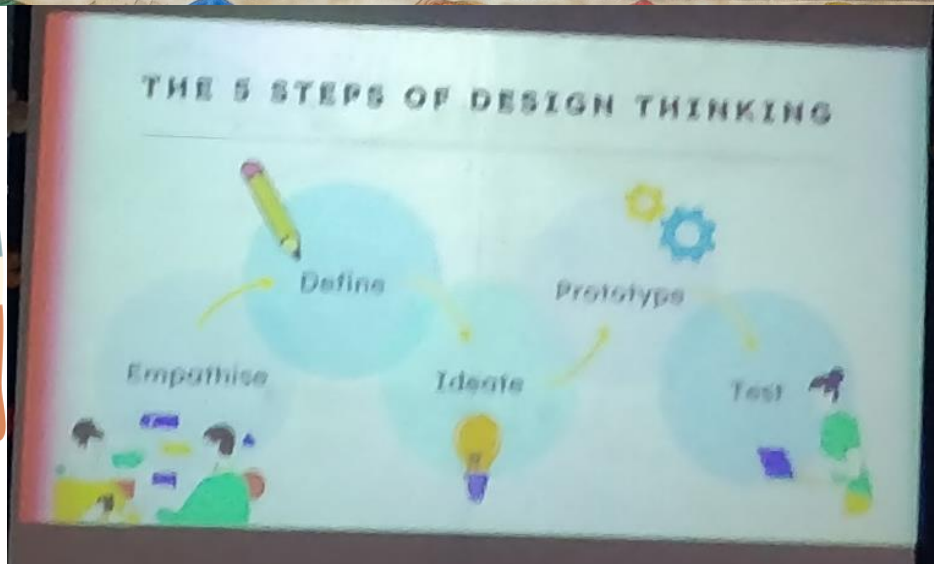
Staff Development Workshop

The workshop was quite interesting and informative. The workshop included several captivating activities which aimed at providing the insights and purpose for Design Thinking.





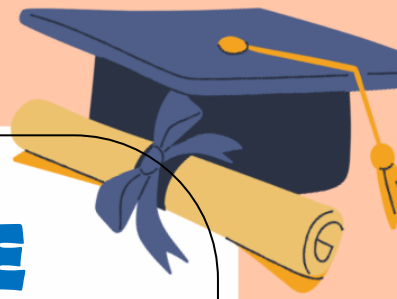
Staff Development Workshop

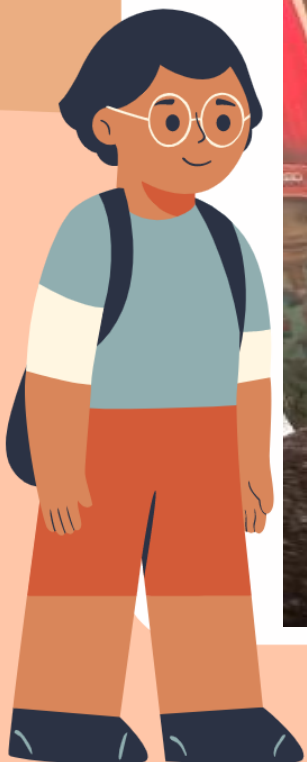
