

The students of our school have made Delhi Region proud by winning at the CBSE National Level Science Exhibition 2022-23 held at Lotus Valley International School Gurugram.

NKBGS displayed its model on "MathBooth " and "VayuSmart" in the category of Mathematics for Us & Environmental Concern respectively. Around 200 schools participated at the regional level held in Delhi on Dec 20, 2022 to Dec 22, 2023. NKBGS won the regionals in both the categories and bagged the honour to represent at the National Level in the CBSE Science Exhibition.






Cyber Safety Training at National Cyber Police Centre on Delhi Police Raising Week Celebration


# NKBGS commemorates Birth Anniversary of its Founder Chairman Sir
