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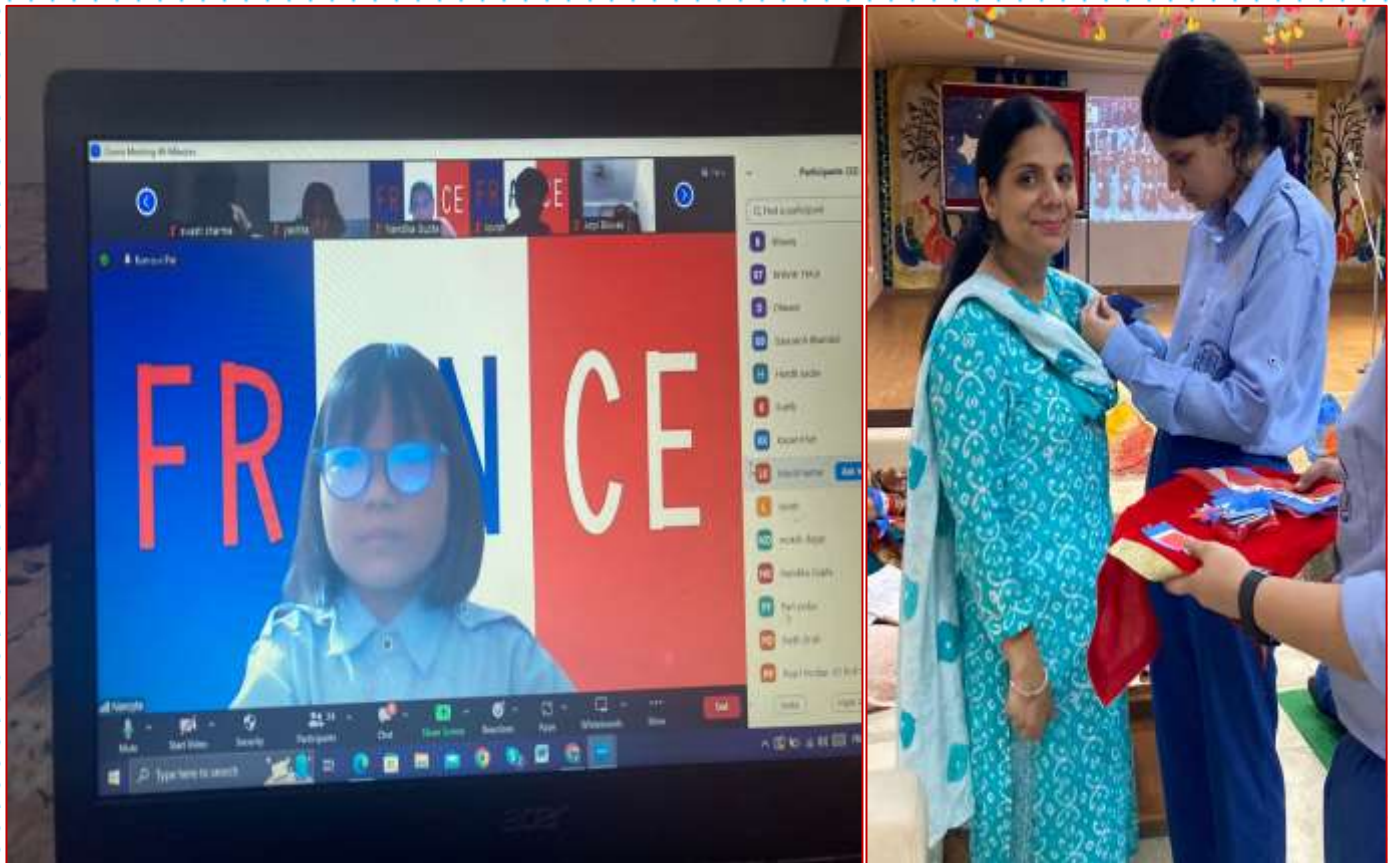


French Day Celebration

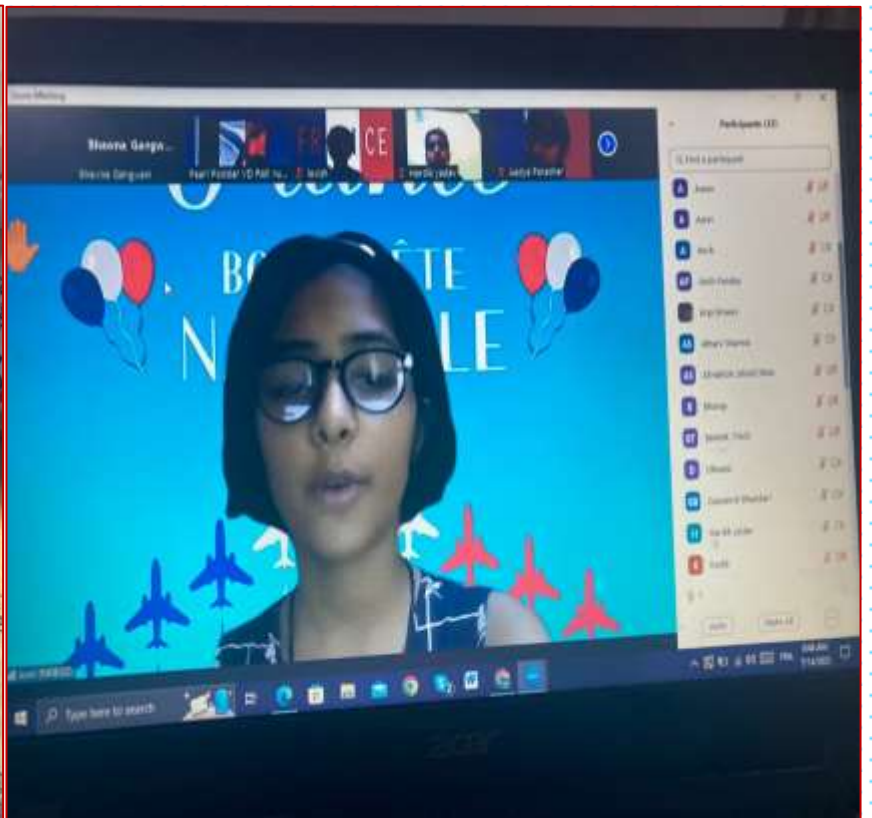
"Imparting the learning of two different languages, both native and foreign, raises our students to a better understanding of varied cultures and unfamiliar customs."

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of Chandrayaan 3 on 21st July to students of classes VI to VIII. The mechanism of Launching was also explained to them so that they could understand technical terms.



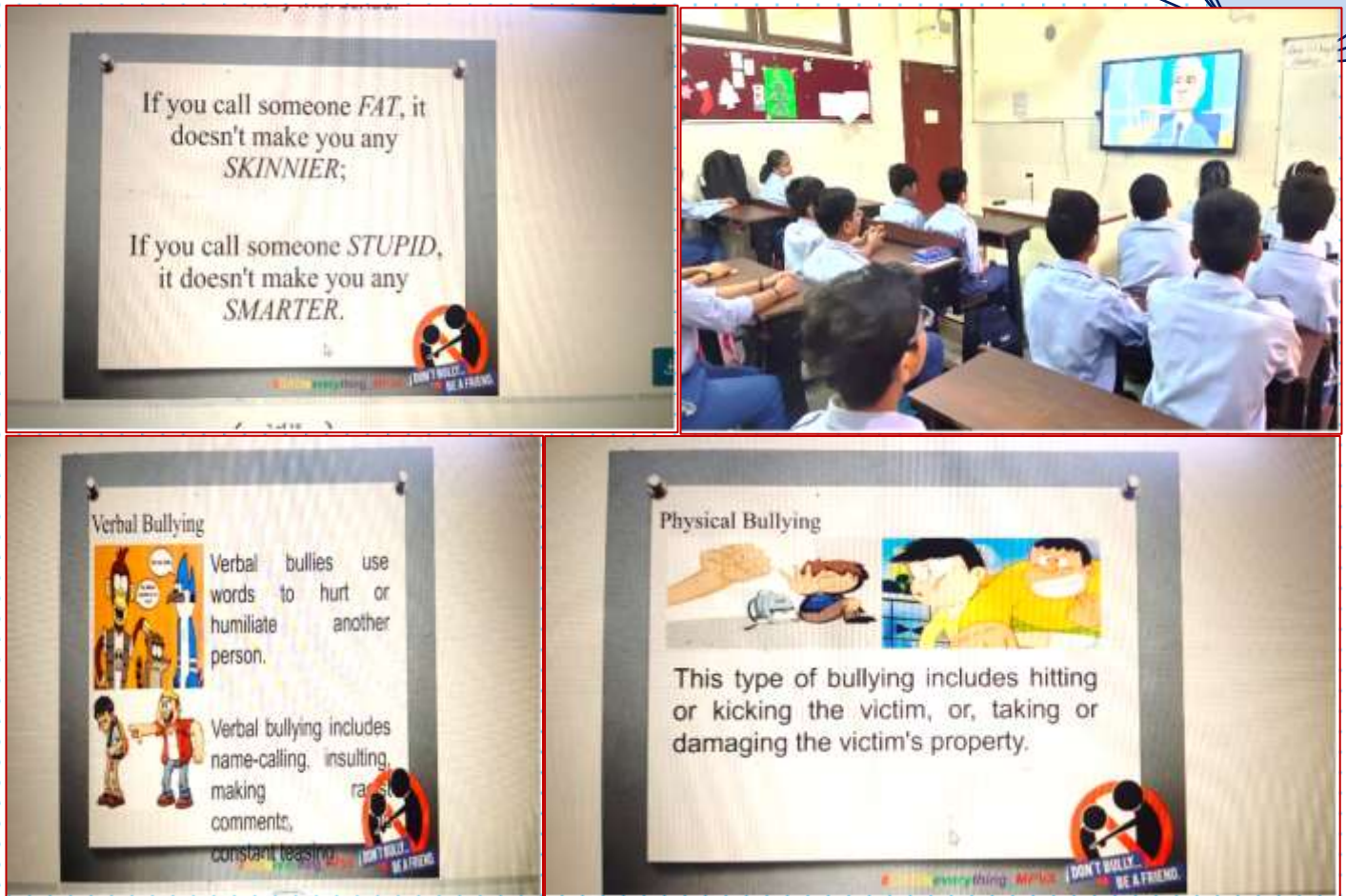
Promoting Anti- Bullying in School

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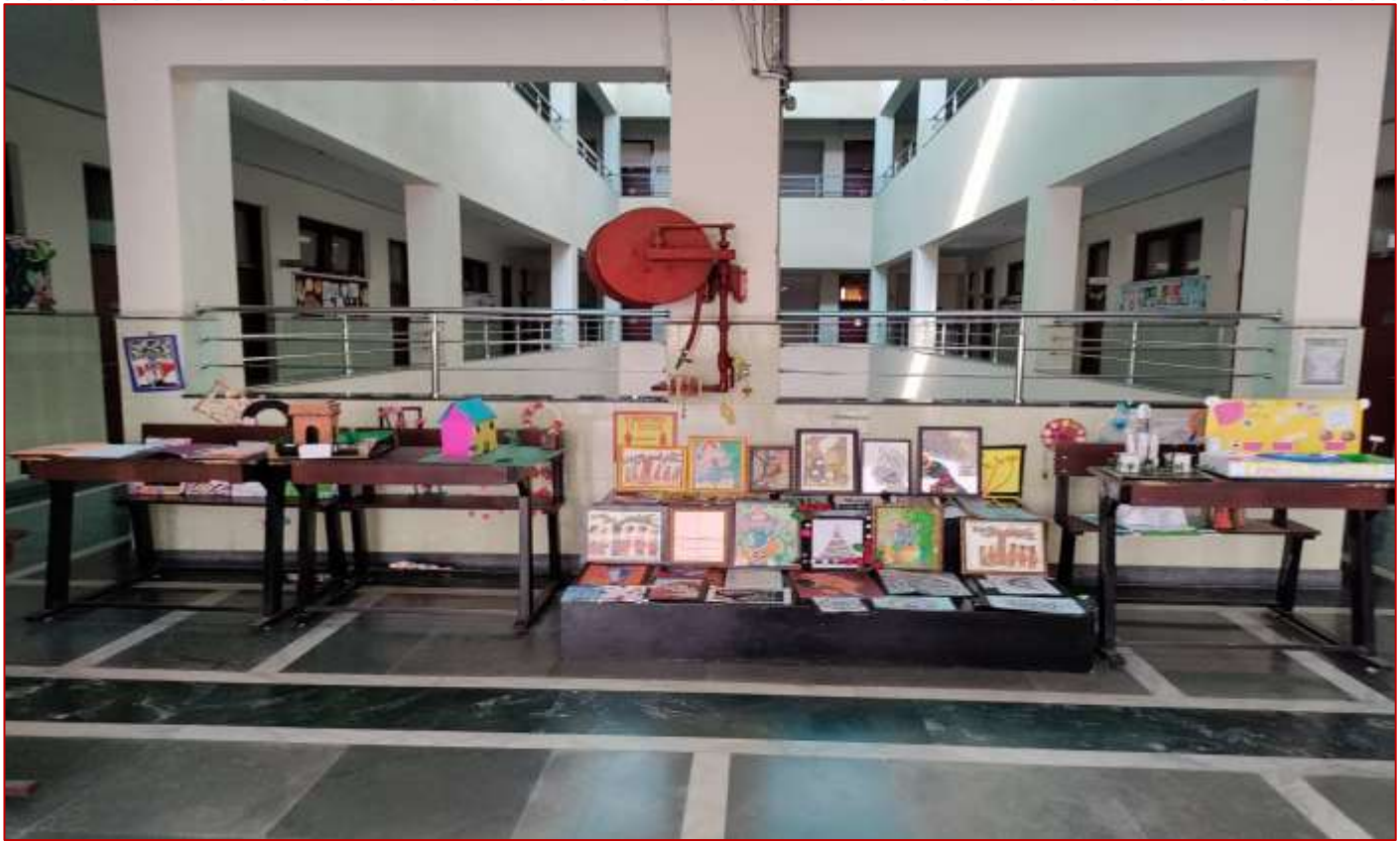


Holiday Homework Exhibition

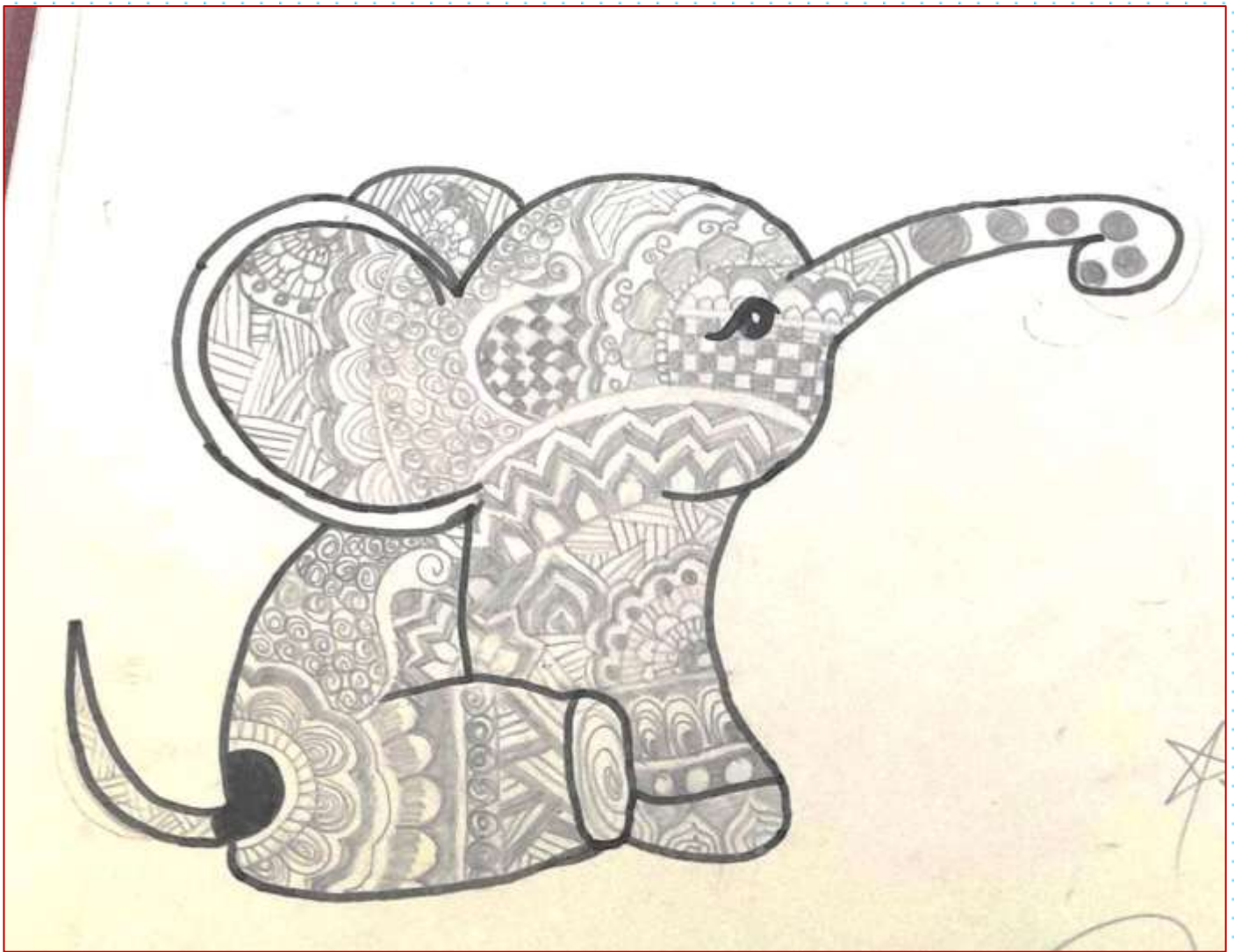

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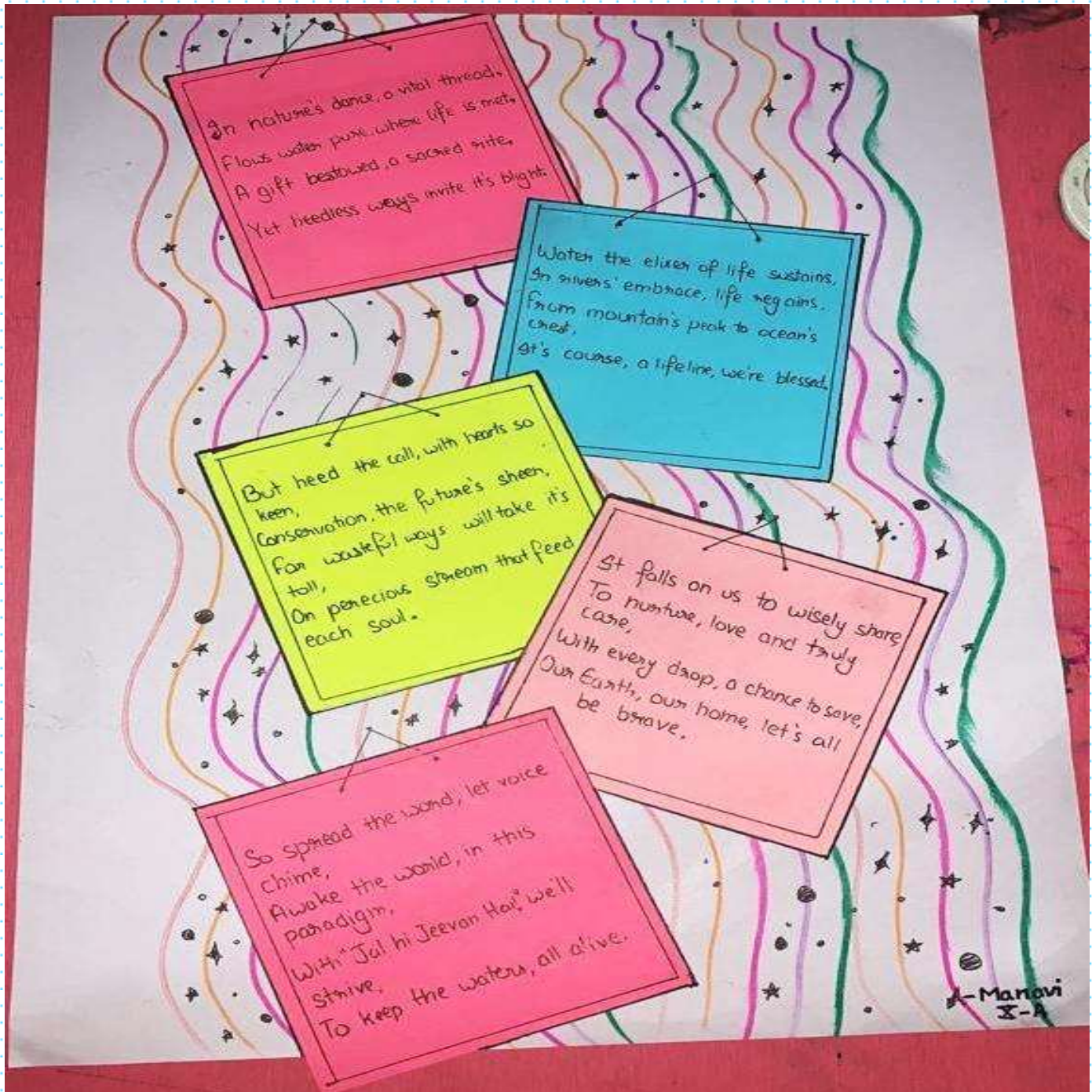

National Counselor Summit

"If you change the way you look at things, the things you look at change."

GD Goenka University and Fortis Hospital co-hosted the National Counselor Summit 2023—Summer Edition on July 21 and 22, 2023, where counselors from various states came together.

On Day 1, the resource person, Dr. Samir Parikh talked about how concerns for kids vary over time, making it crucial to adapt perspectives and approaches to working with children. He emphasized the importance of motivation in bringing about desired behavior and shed light on how our beliefs and experiences shape the way we think.

Certain case studies and researches were presented to examine the reasons why kids don't react to certain situations. Case studies were provided to

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illustrate the comfort and knowledgeable care that psychological assistance can offer to children, as well as the promotion of mental health and the eradication of stigma associated with it.

On Day 2, the session on the POCSO Act led by Ms. Manjula Batra opened the second round of the summit. It was an educational workshop because instances and laws were given to help participants understand which actions and behaviors are covered by the POCSO Act.

The session was well thought out and educational. The workshop was attended by Shreya Handa and Anjali Singh.



Trauma Sensitization Workshop

Connections and the life of an individual might be affected by traumatic events. Additionally, its consequences may make life challenging at work, in social situations, and even at school. Healing and enhancing quality of life are crucial.

On July 20, 2023, Ms. Nitika Arora was invited to present on trauma informedness abilities.

Main features of the workshops were:

- Overreacting and reacting inappropriately to inciting stimuli.

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- Comprehending trauma through the lens of the situation in which the incident occurred is essential for grasping trauma.
- Awareness of the effects of trauma.
- Knowledge of trauma-informed care and the impact of traumatizing
- Awareness of the effects of trauma.
- Comprehending trauma-informed care's shortcomings and its tendency to re-traumatize rather than heal.
