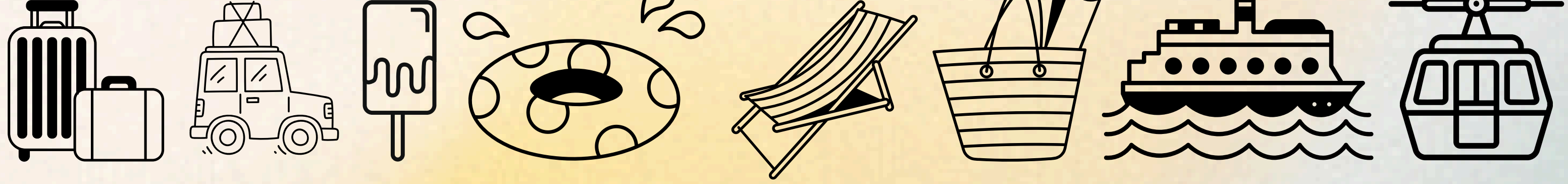

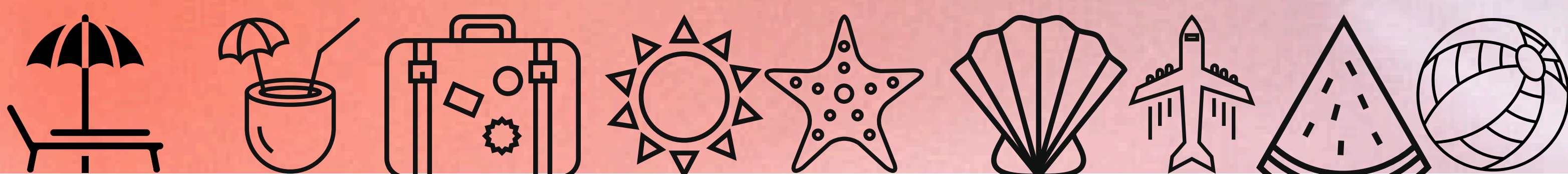

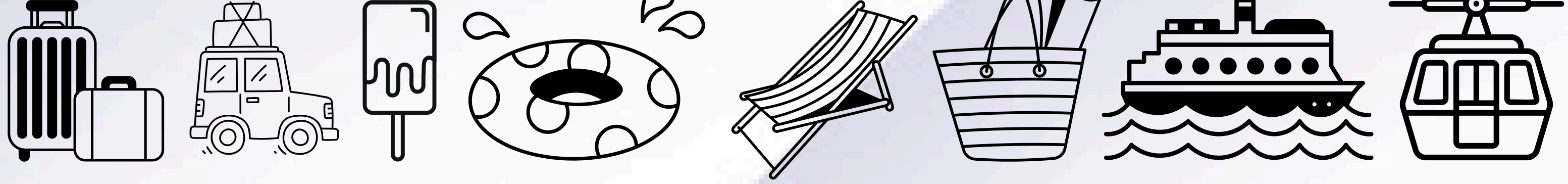
Guidelines to make the summer break more fruitful

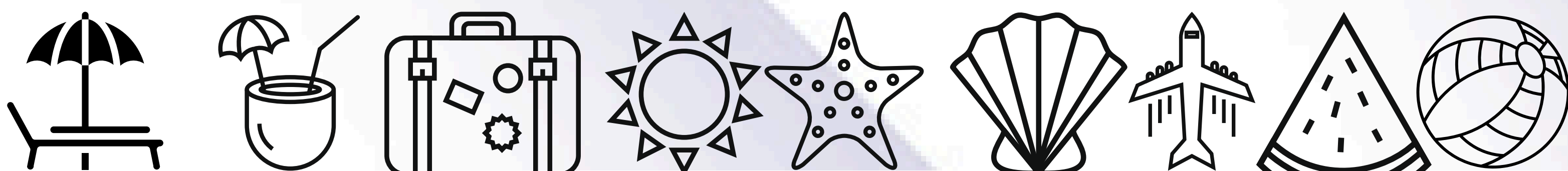

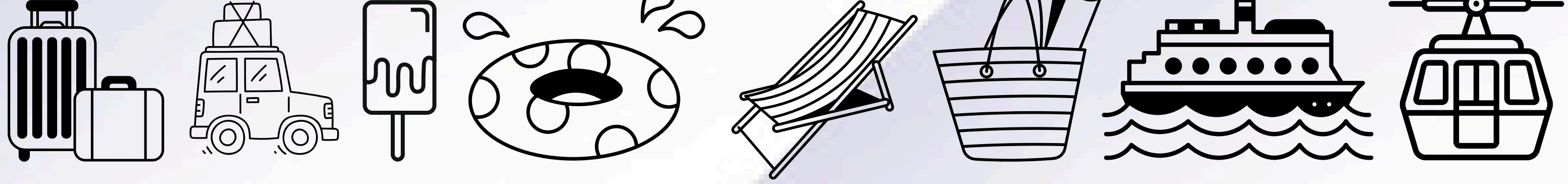

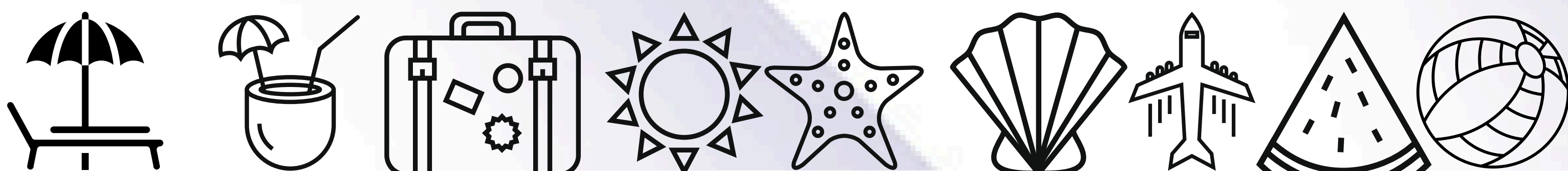
