SECTION- A READING (15 marks)

Q1. Read the passage given below and answer the questions that follow. (1×8=8 marks)

Abraham Lincoln was born on February 12, 1809, in Hardin County, Kentucky, to Thomas and Nancy Lincoln. When Lincoln was just nine years old, his mother died, and his older sister, Sarah, helped care for him until their father remarried. Lincoln had less than a year of formal schooling but was an avid reader, spending many hours with the Bible and other books. By the time he was 17, he was determined to become a lawyer.

At 21, Lincoln moved to Illinois, where he spent a year working on a farm before taking up a job as a storekeeper. His experiences in these roles helped shape his character and commitment to fairness. Despite his limited formal education, Lincoln studied law on his own and, by 1836, passed the bar exam and became a practicing lawyer. His legal career and growing reputation led to his election to the Illinois legislature as a member of the Whig Party, where he honed his skills in debate and public speaking.

Lincoln was elected the 16th President of the United States in March 1861. Just five weeks into his presidency, the Civil War began with the Confederate attack on Fort Sumter. Lincoln was committed to preserving the Union, and his primary goal during the war was to maintain national unity. In 1863, he issued the Emancipation Proclamation, which declared the freedom of slaves in the Confederate states. This landmark action helped set the stage for the eventual abolition of slavery throughout the country.

The Civil War continued until 1865, and Lincoln's leadership was pivotal in navigating the country through its most challenging period. On April 14, 1865, Lincoln and his wife, Mary Todd Lincoln, attended a play at Ford's Theatre in Washington, D.C. The following evening, Lincoln was assassinated by John Wilkes Booth and died the next morning, April 15, 1865.

During Lincoln's presidency, significant events included the attack on Fort Sumter, the issuance of the Emancipation Proclamation, the passing of the Conscription Act (which established a draft for the Union Army), and his famous Gettysburg Address, delivered in November 1863. Lincoln's leadership and vision played a crucial role in shaping the course of American history.


